Description:

Cordoba is a city in Andalusia, Spain, capital of the eponymous province, situated in a depression by the Guadalquivir river and the foothills of Sierra Morena. With more than 350000 habitants.

It is the third city in Andalusia in both size and population, behind only Sevilla and Malaga. Today is a city of moderate size, however, the old town contains architectural memories when Cordoba was the capital of Andalusia province in the Roman Empire and the Caliphate of Cordoba during the Muslim invasion, which ruled much of the Iberian Peninsula. According to archaeological evidence that the city seems to have reached about half a million people back in the tenth century, being the largest city, cultured and opulent worldwide² While the chroniclers of the tenth century, so exaggerated even said that the city had about one million inhabitants.

The mosques, libraries, baths and souks, abounded in the city, the gestating bases of the European Renaissance. During the long European Middle Ages, in "Corduba" sprouted letters and science, telling the city with multiple sources, sewerage and public lighting during the heyday Caliphate.

Its historic center was declared World Heritage by UNESCO in 1984.³ It is a candidate for European Capital of Culture for the year 2016.⁴

Cordoba was the birthplace of three great philosophers: the Roman stoic Seneca, the Muslim Averroes and the Jew Maimonides. Also born in Cordoba poets Lucan, Juan de Mena and Luis de Gongora.
